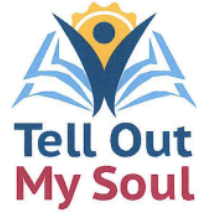

During that time she spent over 90 hours organizing our music collection and completing their finding aids. They are now available for use. The collection contains amongst other information the documentation of choir visits to the United Kingston, photos on the installation of the organ, and a music score by John Searchfield a well-known Calgary choir master. In the last months of 2025 there was an anonymous donation of priceless photos some dating back to 1917 of early clergy and parishioners as well as our Boy Scouts at Fish Creek. Thank you for that!!
