Who we are as a Church

The Anglican Parish of Christ Church is a flourishing church in the heart of Calgary with a rich history and an exciting future. We value our rich liturgical and musical tradition, our commitment to the faith development of our children, our long-term, face-to-face support for refugees, and our desire to be a welcoming parish where people from all walks of life can deepen their love of God and neighbour in a supportive community. We try to balance an intellectual approach to faith with an experiential one as we learn to love God with all our minds and hearts so that with our hands we can love Christ in our neighbours.

We have a talented and playful staff team made up of the Rector, Music Director, Office Administrator, Coordinator of Children, Youth, and Family Ministry, and Preschool Director. Two wise and faithful Honorary Assistants share in the Sunday liturgies. We have a positive and energetic group of lay leaders who are enthusiastic about investing in forward looking approaches to ministry to compliment our traditions. We are a multi-generational congregation, with a higher concentration 60+.

We believe in supporting our clergy. You will be expected to keep Sabbath, to be off when you are on vacation, and to make a yearly spiritual retreat. Your prayer life is important to the church. Who you are is one of the most important things you bring to ministry, so we expect you to attend to your spirit.

Over the next five years our priorities are:

- Continuing to grow our family ministries
- Strengthening the relationships within our congregation as we come back together post-pandemic
- Rejuvenating our adult education ministries
- Becoming a 'mixed economy' church with excellent traditional worship and ministries while exploring new forms of church like Messy Church, dinner church, online church, urban monastery
- Expand the impact of our online ministries by engaging authentically in digital space, not just broadcasting the in-person church experience

Who We are Hoping Will Join Us in Ministry

The Assistant Priest will be mature and highly relational. Pastoral relationships and community connections will be a priority. Opportunities exist for a creative person to bring others alongside them in the ministries of the church. Recruiting, training, and empowering lay people for ministry should be a source of joy for the Assistant Priest.

Personal characteristics of the kind of person we are looking for include:

- Someone who has a mature life of prayer, faith, and service
- A highly relational and compassionate person
- Someone who is gifted in areas of pastoral care, and community building
- Willingness to make a three to five-year commitment to the work of the parish

As Assistant Priest, areas of primary responsibility will be focused on the following ministries:

- Pastoral care, home, and hospital visitation
- Funeral and bereavement care
- Welcoming and integrating newcomers into the life and ministry of the parish
- Growing our connection and integration within the local community

Areas of secondary responsibilities shared with and in support of the Rector include:

- Regular ministrations of the clergy (weddings, funerals, and baptisms)
- Weekly Holy Eucharist services and monthly Senior's Home services
- Regular share in preaching through all seasons of the Church year
- Adult Christian Education & Bible Study

Applicants are asked to outline how their knowledge, skills, and experience align with the vision and goals of Christ Church. Your response should be between 600 and 1300 words in length.
