We are grateful that Margie Newman, our Director of Music Emerita, has come out of retirement to serve as Interim Director of Music to get us through the Rector's sabbatical into the summer.

Our Rector, Brandon, will be away April through July on sabbatical. While he is away, Adam, our Assistant Priest, will be increasing his hours (an increase made possible by the generosity of a Diocesan fund) and will keep regular office hours Monday-Thursday mornings.


#### **Easter flowers**


