Bread Ministry

The Bread Ministry provides bread for the Eucharist every Sunday at the 10.30am service. It is a beautiful symbol of the

Eucharist prayer. We, being many are one body, for we all share in the one bread.

Presently, we have four members who bake bread. Because of our numbers, the bread is fresh one week and we use a frozen loaf for the following week. Ideally, we would have fresh bread for every Sunday.

The bread recipe is extremely easy and is a wonderful opportunity for parents or grandparents to bake with a child. The whole process takes about 3 hours on a Saturday morning.

Recovery means the return of the ability to enjoy happy memories and just to experience moments of joy, which is what we want for you. Registration is not required. 
Pictorial Directory
